NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, for the purpose of regulating traffic during the Cowbridge King Charles III Coronation Parade, Vale of Glamorgan Council has made an Order pursuant to Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, the effect of which is to close to ordinary traffic, the following length of roads, at the discretion of the Chief Police Officer, South Wales Police, at the times indicated, on Sunday 7th May 2023.

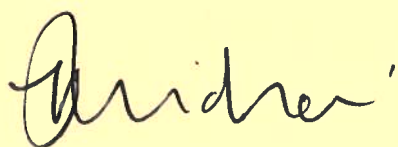
COWBRIDGE - From 11.15am to 12.15pm.

Druids Green	From Eastgate for a distance of 50 metres
Eastgate	Throughout its length
High Street	Throughout its length
Broadshord	From High Street for a distance of 50 metres

It is proposed that it will only be necessary to close the roads for the shortest period possible considered appropriate by the Police, between the above times, in the interests of road safety. Therefore, traffic will not need to be diverted.

This order shall come into operation on Sunday 7th May 2023 and may be cited as "The Vale of Glamorgan Council Town Police Clauses Act 1847 – Section 21 (Cowbridge Coronation Parade) Order 2023
