RDLP

Wi-Fi Mobile Signal

A meeting with Open Reach about town centre Wi-Fi is to be organised. Ofcom are going to use Cowbridge as a Gini pig to see if the signal in Cowbridge is as the provider state and EE have received planning in for new mast in July.

Pedestrian Crossing in Westgate

After I requested a new crossing, there has been a study of 3 potential sites for a crossing



The Middle option is being progressed to the design stage as it had the most people crossing, 192 in 4 days including a Saturday.
