We are a group of Cowbridge residents called the Thaw Valley Group who are very concerned about the development that is proposed for the Thaw Valley in Cowbridge. The site is called called site 370 Bryn Melin.

This site was part of a larger site allocated in the existing LDP and carried forward in the proposed strategy for the RLDP. However the site specified in the LDP is not the same as the site in the RDLP Strategy and some key stringent requirements of the original LDP site allocation have not been adhered to.

We have attached a report outlining these concerns and objections.

We will be making representations to the Vale of Glamorgan Council concerning the inclusion of the site in the strategy document in writing and in person at the upcoming council presentation at Cowbridge Town Hall. (12/1/2024 14.30onwards). You will see from the report that a lot of questions are raised about how this site has passed through the various selection stages to be a candidate site.
