

Action Required: Holycross Churchyard.

Cutting Brambles:

- All brambles across the churchyard need to be cut and cleared to maintain the appearance and prevent overgrowth.

Removing Wildflowers:

- Wildflowers growing in the wall should be removed to prevent structural damage.

Ivy Removal:

- All ivy must be removed as it poses a risk of damaging the structures if left unchecked.
- Special attention is required to remove ivy growing behind the two bins.

Russian Vine Removal:

- The Russian vine, which has grown rapidly and densely, needs to be removed to prevent it from overwhelming other plants and structures.

Bin Removal:

- Remove the two bins from the area.
- Ensure the ivy behind these bins is also cleared.

Pest Control:

- Evidence of rats has been observed. Take necessary measures to control and prevent further rodent activity in the area.

Support for Officers:

- It was suggested that the council receives help from community projects such as the Community probation Service. This comes at a cost of £200 to cover fuel etc however as the saying goes many hands make light work.
